

Niagara County Community College to Canisius College CORE CURRICUL UM TRANSFER GUIDELINES

These general guidelines show how courses from Niagara County Community College (NCCC) serveto complete Canisius College's Core Curriculum requirements. Note that the NCCC course must be a regular course at the 100 level or above and must count for a minimum of 3 credits. Students must earn a course grade of C- or better for transfer credit to apply. It is possible that courses not listed here might be applicable to Canisius Core requirements; students may request a review of specific courses by contacting the Associate Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences. Students can transfer a maximum of 60 credits to Canisius from NCCC or any other two-year college.
