\*Transfer Students wishing to take courses in Spanish who have not taken any courses in Spanish at Canisius, (regardless of intent to major or minor) must first take a placement test. The results of the test will determine the level a student can begin to take courses, and may determine what, if any, transfer credits may be applied toward the major/minor, or as fulfilling requirements in other programs that require language study, or as free electives. The exam can be taken at any time, and is available online. The exam is time limited to an hour, single submission. Students should contact Dr. Richard Reitsma (reitsmar@canisius.edu) and/or the associate dean of CAS for the link to the exam.

\*\*A maximum of 60 credits can be transferred from a two year college to Canisius and a minimum of 18 credits in the major must be completed at Canisius. Students need a minimum of 120 credit hours from their Major, Core Curriculum and free elective courses to meet graduation requirements. Accepted students have a transfer evaluation completed prior to enrollment and work with an advisor to map out a pathway to graduation.
