

Round Table Meet In Science Here Saturday

CATHOLIC SCIENCEMEN TO DISCUSS PROBLEMS;
TO HEAR ZENKERT AT LUNCHEON

On Saturday, May 14, the science department of the College will sponsor a meeting of the Catholic Round Table of Science, given by the Buffalo Chapter of the society. Three prominent members of the Canisius science faculty will have charge of the various departments of the discussion.
