Enclosed is the Canisius College Canadian Student Financial Aid Application for you to complete. Please read the form and instructions carefully.

This is the only form we require Canadian Students to complete in order to be considered for financial aid at Canisius. As you are a Canadian resident, you are ineligible for New York State Aid or United States Federal Aid, but we will consider you for any Canisius College financial aid you may be eligible to receive. We are also asking that you and your parents send our office a copy of the Canadian tax forms filed for 2008.

Please complete the enclosed form and return it to our office. We recommend that you return this form to us by **March 1, 2009** (Freshmen and Transfers), or by **April 15, 2009** (Continuing Students). Students applying for admission after March should complete this financial aid application as soon as possible. We will also need to have the tax information in our office by **June 30, 2009** or we cannot guarantee the availability of all types of institutional financial aid. We also encourage all Canadian students to apply to the Canadian Student Loan Program to help pay for educational costs.

Question 22: If you own a business and/or a farm, include the value of land, machinery, equipment, livestock, investments, and buildings. Do not include the value of the home if it is part of the farm. Do not include the value of a business that you own that has 100 or fewer full-time employees.
