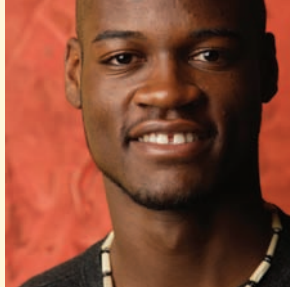

State-of-the-art housing

Many international students live in the Intercultural Living Center (ILC), a special residence for international and American students. The ILC features rooms for one, two or three people, two computer labs, a study lounge, high-speed Internet access for each student, cable television, a large, fully-equipped kitchen and year-round storage.

Students may also choose to live in one of Canisius' other residence halls, which feature suites, apartments and traditional residence living in modern, well-equipped halls. There is always something to do at Canisius, with more than 100 student organizations, 16 NCAA Division 1 athletic teams, and a variety of entertainment and social events throughout the year. From concerts to comedians to academic clubs, honor societies and service organizations, there is something to fit every interest.

Buffalo, New York – a great location with great opportunities

Canisius is located in Buffalo, the second largest city in New York State. It is easy to get to Canisius College. We are located just 10 kilometers from the Buffalo Niagara International Airport, and the bus and train stations are even closer. Buffalo also has quick and easy access to a variety of tourist destinations and other major cities. For example, the world-renowned Niagara Falls is just a 20-minute drive from campus. Toronto, Canada is only a 90-minute drive. New York City is an hour away by plane.

Our campus is located in a residential section of central Buffalo, a short walk from the Buffalo Zoo, scenic Delaware Park, and just minutes from the Albright Knox Art Gallery and the Elmwood entertainment and shopping district. The best of Buffalo is all easily accessed because students at Canisius are provided with free use of the city's public transportation system. From theater to nightlife, dining to professional sports such as ice hockey, lacrosse and American football, Buffalo is an exciting college city.

Scholarships

Undergraduate international students may be eligible for scholarships based on their academic achievements. You will be considered for a scholarship when you apply for admission. Scholarship notifications are sent with the acceptance letters for admitted students.

Graduate students may be eligible for a limited amount of scholarship money and assistantships to help offset the cost of tuition. The assistantships and scholarships are awarded in June for the next academic year for incoming graduate students.

How to apply

To apply for undergraduate admission, please fill out the international application located on the Canisius Web site at www.canisius.edu/international. You must submit official copies of all transcripts from secondary schools and any colleges attended. You will also need to complete the Sources of Financial Support form and send certified bank statements in order for the college to issue you an I-20.
