June 18, 1911 was one of the brightest days in the annals of Canisius College. Hundreds of college faculty, students and community members gathered for a celebratory procession that ended at the “New Canisius College,” where the cornerstone was laid for Old Main (above photo).

The signature building of the new campus at Main and Jefferson was formally dedicated on December 30, 1912 and marked a new era in the history of Canisius College. Old Main's golden dome has since become a symbol of this great college.

Now, nearly 90 years and thousands of graduates later, a \$12 million renovation project has made Old Main new again — replacing old school classrooms with state-of-the-art technology facilities and restoring the beauty of the building's craftsmanship.

This November, Canisius College is celebrating the renewal of Old Main as we rededicate this landmark structure.
