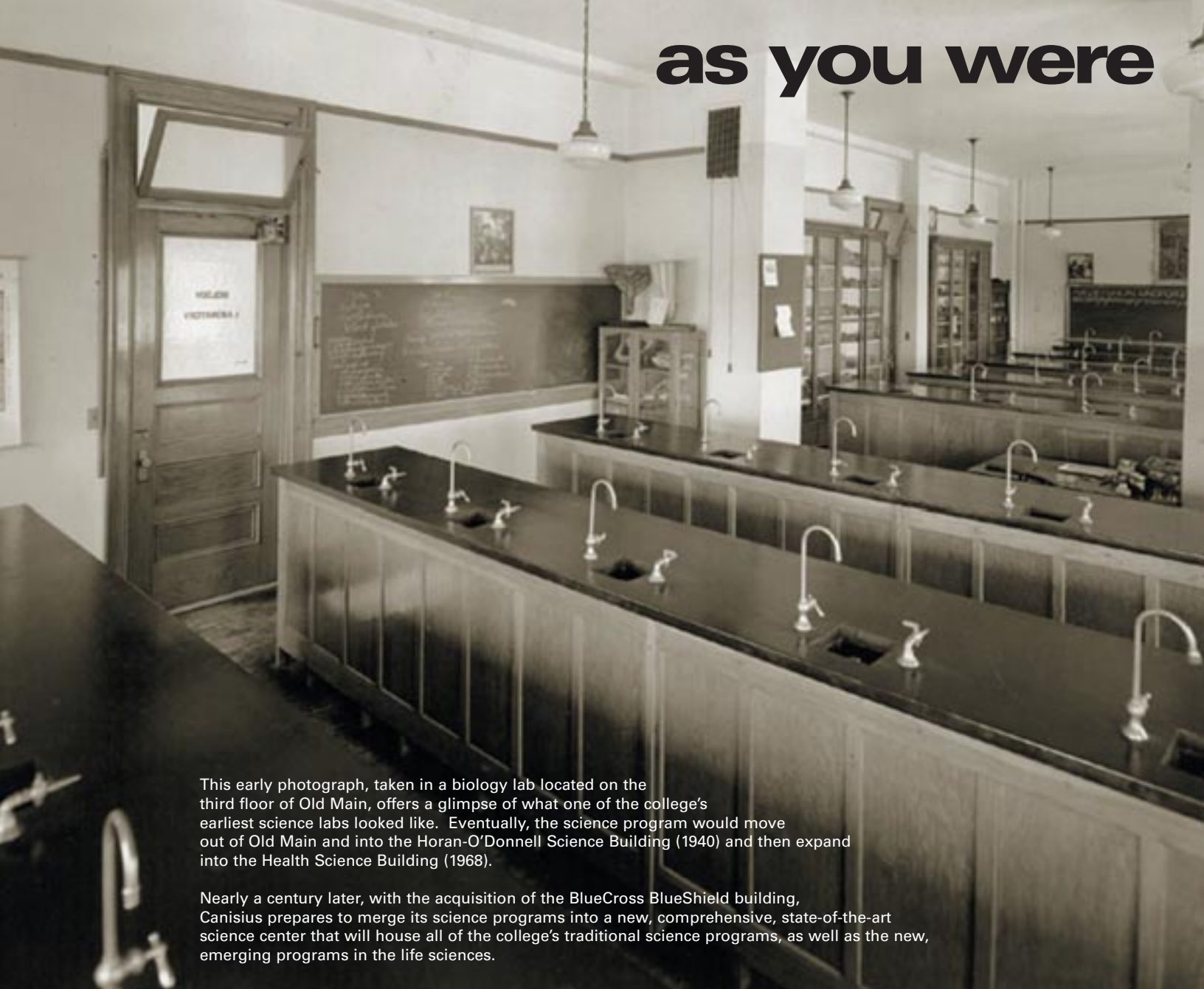


# as you were
