played a total of 15 games; 10 of which were credited to Canisius, four to their opponents and one that resulted in a tie. Canisius played Niagara twice that year. On December 5, the five-man team from Niagara journeyed down from the Falls with about 50 rooters. After a fast and exciting game, the Canisius boys were proclaimed the victors by a score of 27-22. Varsity was not so fortunate in its second match against Niagara December 17. On that date, 150 Canisius students and friends invaded the Falls and saw their team go down in defeat by a score of 35-16.
