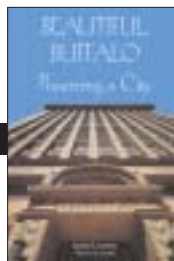
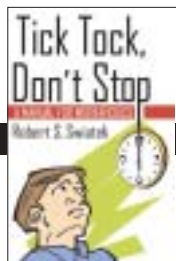


Alumni Authors



From self-help to historic Buffalo, books by Canisius College alumni are lining bookstore shelves.

Among them is **Robert S. Swiatek's** *Tick Tock, Don't Stop*. In it, the 1964 alumnus shares his secret for living a more productive life with less effort. The book chronicles the origins of work, how it has changed through the years and why most of us don't really like it too much. Swiatek also uses his professional experiences as a computer software consultant to provide valuable tips on how to enhance your time, on and off the job.

In *Lizzie & Other Stories from an Irish-American Boyhood*, **Martin B. Breen '52** writes about the 1930s – the era in which he grew up. The book includes the short stories Breen heard as a young boy from the unemployed men, who became regulars at his family-owned tavern on Seneca Street in South Buffalo during the Great Depression.

"Originally I wrote the book because I thought it would be nice to have my children and grandchildren understand what life was like growing up in the 1930s," says Breen. "As it turns out, the book has received a tremendous response from people in the community and those that grew up during that era."

Buffalo's architectural heritage and the city's efforts to preserve it are documented in the new book *BEAUTIFUL BUFFALO, Preserving a City*. Co-authored by the late Linda Levine, a former art and architecture critic for *Buffalo Spree* magazine, and freelance writer and former *Buffalo News* reporter **Maria B. Scrivani '76**, *BEAUTIFUL BUFFALO* features archival and contemporary photographs of historic Buffalo sites designed by America's greatest architects including Frank Lloyd Wright, Louis Sullivan and Stanford White. It also details how

Buffalo's architectural masterpieces survived despite recent decades of declining population and an eroding industrial base.

BEAUTIFUL BUFFALO was published this fall by Canisius College Press, as was *Gothic Grandeur: A Rare Tradition in American Catholicism*. Written by C. Eugene Miller, a retired research scientist who now studies historical subjects, and co-edited by **Michael A. Riester '79**, an archivist at St. Louis Church in Buffalo, *Gothic Grandeur* interprets the internal and external historical forces that shaped St. Louis Church, the first Catholic church in the Buffalo Diocese.

From its foundation to evolution and its rise and decline, all of which are intricately connected to Buffalo's growth, the book serves as a scholarly narrative, which details the lives of the St. Louis Church parishioners throughout its 175-year existence.

"The Independent 529 Plan provides a way for parents to contribute and pay for a private college, such as Canisius, without worrying about either investment risk or tuition inflation," explains Dr.

Laurence W. Franz, the college's vice president for business & finance and treasure.

"Think of it as buying a shopping certificate for use at any of the stores at a mall," adds Doug Brown, president and CEO of Tuition Plan Consortium, which oversees the Independent 529 Plan. "Students don't choose their college at purchase, only after they have applied and are accepted in the regular manner."

Canisius offers an added incentive to plan purchasers: a one percent discount off the price of tuition and fees, each year, until the student enrolls.

You've Got Mail!

Undoubtedly, one of the most effective communication tools in the 21st century is E-mail. At Canisius, we recognize the benefits of electronic communication and utilize it to stay connected with our college alumni. It can be even more effective with your help.

Out of approximately 34,000 alumni, only 7,000 E-mail addresses are housed in the college database. It was a very moving day for these alumni and as a result of the publicity surrounding these degree recipients, the College Relations Office has heard from many former students who did not learn of this program until it was too late. In an effort to address as many situations as possible, Canisius would like to once

again offer special diplomas to students who meet the following criteria:

- Attended Canisius for at least two years
- Left Canisius early to attend professional schools, which allowed for admission without an undergraduate degree: schools of law, medicine and dentistry
- Did not receive an undergraduate degree from any other institution

Qualified students will need to provide the college with a copy of their professional school transcripts and diplomas. Canisius will reconcile the transcripts with the corresponding Canisius transcripts and

certify those that are eligible to receive degrees. Once officially certified, students will be invited to receive their Canisius degrees from President Rev. Vincent M. Cooke, S.J., during commencement ceremonies on May 22, 2004.

Letters have been sent to those former students who appear eligible. The deadline for applications is January 31, 2004.
