

Residence hall living has come a long way since Bosch Hall first opened to Canisius students in fall 1968. The picture below shows what the average dorm room looked like when the residence opened more than 30 years ago.

Named for the late Rev. Raymond G. Bosch who taught for 35 years in the college's Modern Languages Department, Bosch Hall was the second residence hall to be constructed at Canisius. When it opened, the six-story building housed 319 students plus five faculty proctors. Bosch Hall was renovated in 1996 and today, the building is home to approximately 250 students who live in in double and suite style rooms.
