# By the Numbers

Did you know there are 37,456 living Canisius alumni? That's an impressive number. In fact, the Canisius alumni population has grown nearly 15 percent since 1998. Perhaps the best news is that alumni across the country are more involved with *alma mater* than ever before. The establishment of 15 regional alumni chapters and the outstanding chapter leadership committees, who plan and promote alumni programming in their hometowns, are a significant reason why.

Although the greatest number of Canisius alumni continue to make their homes in the

Northeast, an increasing number are migrating to the Southeast (up 54 percent from 1998) and the Northwest (up 45 percent from 1998).

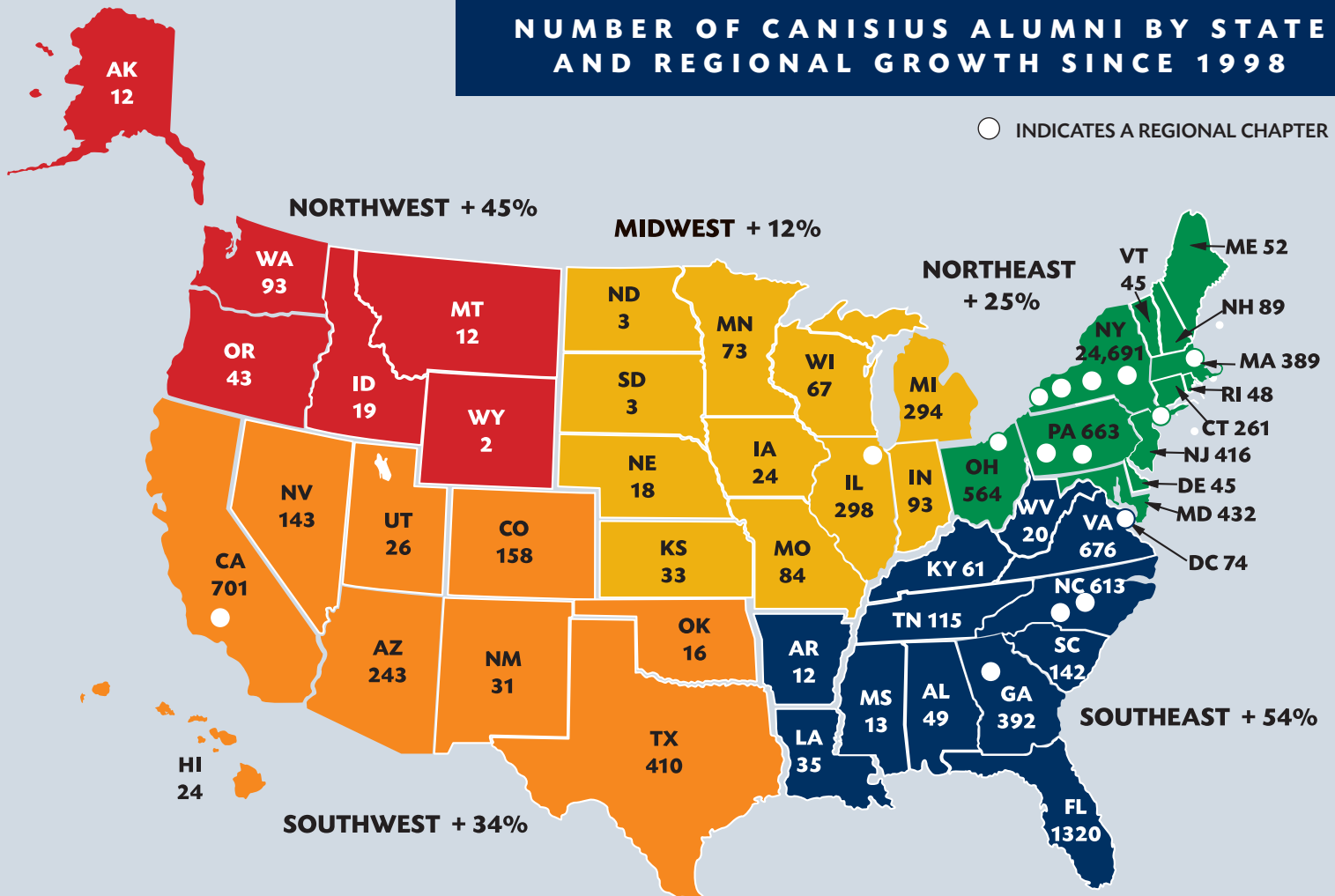

## Former CIA Analyst a Spokesman for Alma Mater

Don't ever let it be said that Canisius alumni aren't the best spokespersons for the college. During a July 7 interview on C-SPAN, **Michael F. Scheuer '74, PhD**, was asked where he attended college. The former 22-year veteran of the Central Intelligence

Agency (CIA) enthusiastically replied, "Only the best Jesuit college in the country: Canisius!"

Scheuer appeared on C-SPAN to comment on the CIA's announcement that it closed Alec Station, the special unit at the Counterterrorism Center assigned to track and eliminate Osama bin Laden. As a former CIA counterterrorism analyst, Scheuer served as chief of Alec Station from 1996-1999 and remained with the special unit until his resignation from the CIA in 2004.

"What I liked best about working at the agency was that it was a worthwhile job," says Scheuer. "I was always involved in covert action programs that were designed to protect the United States so it was a very fulfilling job to know that what we did made a difference."

Widely considered one of the foremost experts on Osama bin Laden, Scheuer is the author of *Imperial Hubris: Why the West is Losing the War on Terror* and *Through Our Enemies' Eyes: Osama bin Laden, Radical Islam, and the Future of America*. Both were originally published anonymously. He also serves as a terrorism analyst for CBS News and the Jamestown Foundation's on-line publication *Global Terrorism Analysis*.

Scheuer says, "The agency puts a high premium on integrity, honesty and candor, and these are values I carried with me from Canisius."

In fact, the Jesuit tradition is still a significant presence in Scheuer's life. He currently teaches a course for the Securities Studies Program in the School of Government and Foreign Policy at Georgetown University.

"The whole attitude of the Jesuits is very important to me," says Scheuer. "Canisius professors such as Father Dunn (Rev. Edward T. Dunn, S.J.) and Dr. Valaik (J. David Valaik, PhD, professor *emeritus*) emphasized the ideas of self discipline and integrity. I've tried to carry them with me throughout my life."

## Canisius has a Star in Concannon

From Regis Philbin to Angelina Jolie and Sarah Ferguson, this celebrity list of names is only a sampling of the many well-known stars that **Brendan T. Concannon '92** has dressed since graduating from *alma mater*. A highly-sought after stylist, Cannon – as he's known in the industry – has created 'looks' for numerous A-list actors, musicians and models. His work can be seen on runways, magazines, top-rated television shows and commercials. This past year, Cannon worked with the American hip-hop group Black Eyed Peas, and the casts of popular television shows "The Office," "The Sopranos" and "Lost."

Cannon credits his Canisius education for providing him with the building blocks to succeed. He recalls the late Marilyn G.S. Watt, PhD, former chair of the Communication Studies Department, who "took me under her wing ... and groomed me for the exciting career I have today."

Cannon adds, "Canisius allowed me to create my own opportunities." As a member of the student senate, a writer for *The Griffin*, a disk jockey for the campus radio station, WCCG, and president of CCTV (the Canisius College television station), Cannon says, "those activities let me be totally creative."

They also prepared him for various jobs early in his career. Upon graduation, Cannon moved home to New York City where he did promotions and disc jockey work. Then, "One day I went to a fashion shoot with a friend who was modeling and it all came together. Before I knew it, I started working with Annie Lennox and Michael Jackson. That connected me to Sony Music and from there it has been smooth sailing."

Cannon can now be seen as a guest stylist on "Cover Shot," a new makeover program, which gives everyday women the opportunity to become a magazine model. "Cover Shot" airs Fridays at 10:00 p.m. on TLC.
