Paul and Walter Fitzpatrick established the Chair of Political Science in 1958, in memory of their father, who was chair of the Erie County Democratic Party. In 1962, the Fitzpatrick Chair began to sponsor an acclaimed lecture series, in which government, academic and journalism professionals are invited to campus to share their political insights with the Canisius community. President Truman served as the inaugural speaker for the lecture series.
