Pictured at left is the steel framework that serves as the foundation for Frisch Residence Hall. Construction of the facility began in summer 1962 to accommodate the college's growing student body, which climbed nearly 15 percent between 1961 and 1962.

Four decades later, Canisius continues to construct new housing (Eastwood Residence Hall) to meet its expanding enrollment numbers. In June, the college was forced to close enrollment, for the first time in its history, when the 2004 freshman class reached full enrollment.
