The uniforms have changed but the game is still the same. Pictured (above) is the Canisius College baseball team of 1892. Although little is known about the college's athletic history from those early years, a Rev. Mueller, S.J, provides some insight in "A Short History of Canisius College and its Development." The 12-page document, which covers the years 1869-1894, is handwritten by Father Mueller in German, an excerpt reads: "[Canisius College] has always promoted the usual youth games with the required supervision and with reasonable moderation, subjugated to the higher goal; besides suitable walks and at least in summer time, regular recreation day visits to the Villa that belonged to the college."
