

Cary Composition Applauded

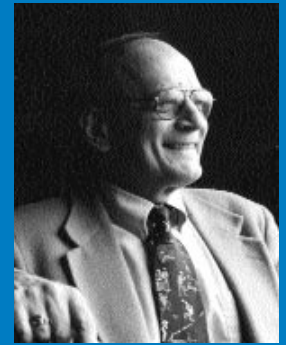
The National Music Foundation named **Jane C. Cary**, assistant professor of fine arts and director of music, a semi-finalist in its American Music Education Initiative.

associate professor of elementary education at Pennsylvania's

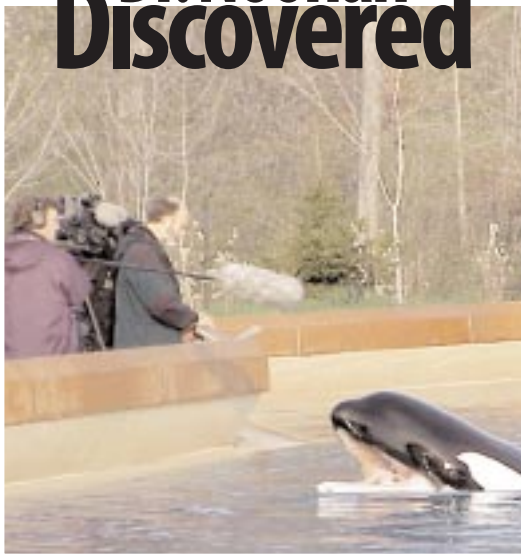

The publication details hundreds of early and recently commissioned reviews of Ellison's most renowned novel, *The Invisible Man*, as well as several other fiction and non-fiction works by the author. *The Critical Response to Ralph Ellison* is available at most college, university and public libraries. It is Dr. Butler's fifth book.
