Elaine F. Sciolino '70, a senior writer in the Washington bureau of the *New York Times*, has authored her second book. *Persian Mirrors: The Elusive Face of Iran* chronicles Sciolino's 20 years of reporting on the troubled nation.

A veteran reporter, Sciolino covered such high-profile stories as the Iranian Revolution, the Iran hostage crisis, the Iran-Iraq War and the death of Pope John Paul I.

*Persian Mirrors* was released in the fall and is available in bookstores nationwide. Sciolino's first book, *The Outlaw State: Saddam*

*Hussein's Quest for Power and the Gulf Crisis*, was released in 1991.

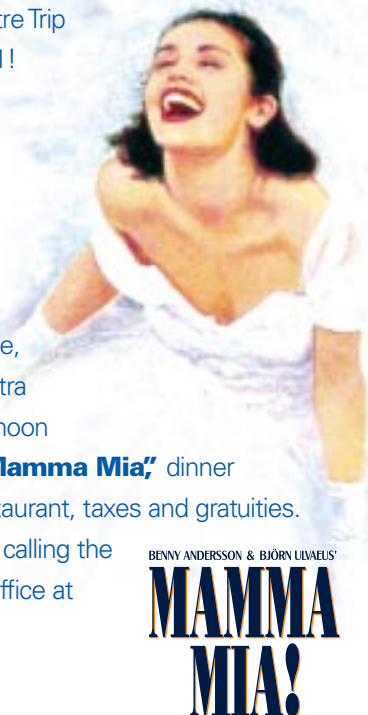
