



On Saturday, March 20, 1965 a Greyhound bus carrying 33 Canisius College students, two Jesuit priests and the college's dean of men began a 1,000 mile journey to Selma, Alabama. Once there, the Canisius delegation converged with thousands of other civil rights activists, including Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., and joined in a historic march to protest the south's social injustices against African Americans and their right to vote.
