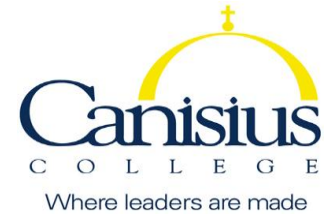

***Childhood or Adolescence Certification***  
***For Deaf Education Candidates without prior certification***

This program is for graduate students enrolled in the Teacher of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing program who do not have teacher certification in New York state. Candidates must pick either Childhood certification (grades 1-6) or Adolescence certification (grades 7-12). The education courses can be taken concurrently with the Deaf Education courses. Candidates must also complete the Deaf Education courses listed on the reverse page for Teacher of the Deaf certification.

Candidates for Adolescence must also meet the requirements for an academic content teaching discipline (English, French, German, Spanish, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Social Studies).
