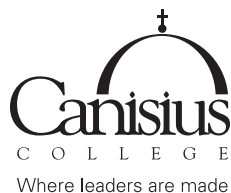


# International Student Certification of Finances

## General Directions

All international applicants must submit proof of their ability to meet all educational and living expenses for the entire period of study before Canisius can issue a Certificate of Visa Eligibility (Form I-20). Your certificate of finance **must** have enough funds listed and verified on page three to cover the cost of your educational expenses listed on page two.

**Please complete the next two pages and return the entire document with verification to the address below. Be sure to include all necessary financial documents and signatures.**

Source of Funds	Required Verification
Personal/Family..... Savings	Signature of sponsors on this form and bank verification in a separate letter/ statement of account with a signature of a bank official.
Scholarships..... Sponsors/Relatives	Official award letter from the institution awarding the scholarship. The award letter must contain the name of the applicant, the amount of money available each year of study, the beginning and ending dates of the award, and the name of Canisius College as the institution to which the award is applicable.
Loans.....	Official letter from the financial institution indicating approval of the loan and the amount of the loan.
Government or ..... Employer	Official letter from the financial institution indicating support and containing the same information as scholarships described above.

## Please note the following:

- Bank letters/statements carry no liability on the part of the bank.
- All documentation must be dated within one year of the date of initial enrollment at Canisius College.
- The information is required for visa eligibility determination only.
- Copies of the certificate of finances and supporting documentation will be submitted with your Certificate of Visa Eligibility (Form I-20) to the Immigration and Naturalization Service when you enter the United States at your point of entry.
- All international students must complete this document.

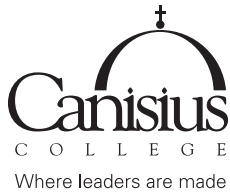
