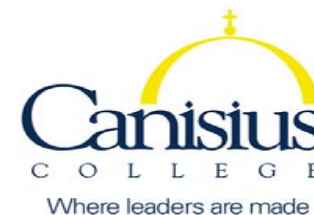

College Student Personnel Administration integrates classroom learning and experiential education. Each of the two required internships requires a minimum of 225 hours of experience. A number of graduate assistantships are also available, offered by a variety of offices in student and academic affairs.

Together, each year all of the students in the program attend one of the two national student affairs conferences (ACPA or NASPA). The cost of attendance for each of the two years, including travel, hotel and conference registration, is included in the cost of tuition for full time students. This underlines our belief in the importance of professional development and networking. The cost of books is also included in the tuition.
