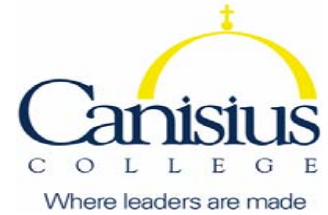

The Health and Human Performance Master of Science Degree Program at Canisius College trains students in the areas of rehabilitative and preventive health, with special emphasis on cardiopulmonary rehabilitation and health promotion.

The 35 credit hour MS program offers students the choice between an internship or a research (thesis) experience. The program prepares students to practice in clinical settings as part of a health care team or to practice in exercise and health-promotion programs with apparently healthy or high-risk populations.

The curriculum will provide students with appropriate course work and field experiences to prepare for the American College of Sports Medicine (ACSM) Health Fitness Instructor (HFI) certification or the Exercise Specialist (ES) exam.
