

## Scheduling Information for Adolescence Education (Spring 2010)

We offer many scheduling options to provide you with the most convenient and flexible choices; the possibilities are almost endless. You may attend on a full time or part time basis.

Any prospective student can view class scheduling options online. From the Canisius Web site, click on "current students"; then click on "Online Registration/check your grades/view your 1098-T"; then click on "Class schedule" to view current, previous and some future semesters.

**Note:** EDAD courses are listed under the subject heading of Adolescence Education, EDU courses are listed under Teacher Education, EMC courses are listed under Educ. Middle Childhood.

### Sample Schedule for New Students: Spring 2010 (January 19 - May 15)

**New students will also register for EDAD 598** as a non-credit course. This is a one time seminar providing detailed information specific to the program. The seminar will be held on Monday, January 25, 2010 from 3:45-5 pm (location TBD).

**\*Business & Marketing candidates** substitute EMC 552A on Monday from 1-3:45 pm.

\*\*EDAD 502 includes 30 hours of field experience, outside of the class period (may still be completed on Mon or Tue). The instructor will make student placements in Buffalo area schools.

**To complete the master's degree coursework in two semesters**, add EDAD 538 on Tuesday from 1-3:30 pm. There are two options: Social Sciences & Education or New Literacies.

**If classes are closed while attempting to register**, contact the Graduate Education Office at 888-2545 or 800-950-2505. In most cases, we can add you to closed sections or recommend an alternate schedule to meet your needs.

**Friday-Saturday Program.** Adolescence Education does not have course offerings to complete the program on a Friday-Saturday schedule.

**Web Option:** Students can limit their travel to campus by taking on-line courses to complete coursework requirements for certification. The following courses are currently available online: EDU 505, EDAD 534 and EDAD 535. Web courses may be identified via the WEA, WEB, WEC section identifiers on the registration screen.

**During the summer** (mid-May thru late July), Canisius offers two five-week sessions. Courses meet two times per week, including the Monday-Tuesday schedule.

**EDAD 537: Advanced Teaching Methods: Adolescence** is scheduled the term prior to student teaching. The course consists of 70 hours of field experience in a secondary classroom and evening seminars. Seminars are conducted on Monday during the class period for US students and Thursday (in Ontario) for Canadian students.

Certification coursework can be completed in 2 semesters by completing four courses each semester. Student teaching placements may be completed during the third semester. Student teaching is conducted Monday-Friday during the fall or spring semesters. Student teaching can not be completed during the summer.

**\*Business & Marketing K-12 substitute EMC 552 in the first term and EMC 553 in the second term.**

**To finish the master's degree coursework in two semesters,** take EDAD 538 during first semester and EDAD 616 during the second. Candidates who already have initial teaching certification may take EDAD 538 and EDAD 616 during the same semester to complete the master's degree. Canadian candidates with 3-year bachelor's degrees must complete the master's degree coursework before applying for initial teaching certification.
