Who is eligible? All Catholic school teachers, counselors and administrators within the Diocese of Buffalo who meet the criteria for admission.

Award(s): 1/3 tuition scholarship (from The Vincent and Harriet Palisano Foundation and Canisius College)
1/3 tuition scholarship for administrators (from the Diocese of Buffalo)

Programs: Childhood Education (grades 1-6), initial certification/master's degree
Adolescence Education (grades 7-12), initial certification/master's degree
Adolescence Education – English, for professional certification
Adolescence Education – Social Studies, for professional certification
Deaf Education
Differentiated Instruction
Educational Administration and Supervision
Literacy
Physical Education, initial and professional certification programs
School and General Counseling
Special Education
General Education (only for teachers with provisional certification)

Procedures: **For the Palisano Scholarship,** apply for admission and enroll in any of the above master's degree programs; secure employment verification form from the Graduate Education Office or our Web site; obtain signature of pastor or principal and return form to Canisius for 1/3 tuition scholarship.

For the Diocese Administrator Scholarship, follow the procedure described above to receive the Palisano/Canisius Scholarship. A limited number of candidates may also receive an endorsement from the Diocesan Superintendent of Schools for an additional 1/3 tuition scholarship.
