

TurnItIn for Students

TurnItIn is a web-based system that identifies text and portions of text that have been published on the web. Use of this software allows students to check to see if their papers contain their own original work, and it allows instructors to identify those papers that have too much unoriginal text, indicating plagiarism, whether intended or not.

To use TurnItIn, you must have a User Profile. See the document *“Create a User Profile in TurnItIn”* for instructions.

Once you have created your User Profile, you can access TurnItIn at: www.turnitin.com and login with your email address and password.

Student Submission of Papers

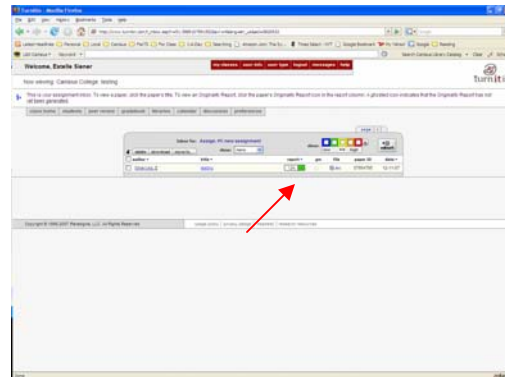
Your Instructor will need to give you a Class ID and enrollment password in order to use TurnItIn. Once you have that information, you can login to TurnItIn to submit your paper. Use your email address and TurnItIn password. Then enter your **Class ID** and **enrollment password**. Click on the Assignment name and then click the Submit link to submit their papers.

Enter your first name and last name, and title of your paper. Browse to the file to attach, and click **Submit**. A preview of paper is displayed. If it is the correct one, click Yes, Submit. If not, click No, go back and re-submit.

After submission of the paper, TurnItIn will start the check. It may take a few minutes.

Getting the Results

To view the results of the check, click the paper's Originality Report icon in the report column. A ghosted icon indicates that the Originality Report has not yet been generated.



This sample shows 12% non-original indicating that most of your paper is original; that is, not copied from a source that you used. If you find a large portion of your text is flagged from a particular source, you should make sure the source properly attributed in your paper.



Close report window and logout to leave Turnitin.
