

**Box 28 – Stormograph Charts (15 interior boxes)
ca. 1941-1956**

Scope note: Boxes 29 and 31 contain Taylor Stormograph Charts which recorded the activity of the Earth on the seismograph drum in the Canisius College Seismograph Station. The chart paper was installed on the seismograph clock drum, and rotated until the recording pen lay opposite the correct time of day. When setting the pen against the chart, a drop of ink was added and moved lightly back and forth to ensure a perfect flow of ink.

Charts were changed on Monday for accurate times records. If changed on other days , allowance needed to be made for the overlap which would throw the timing of the subsequent record off about 6 hours.

Notations made by Dr. Austin C. McTigue and Rev. James J. Ruddick are visible on the charts.
