

Scheduling Information for Physical Education (Summer 2009) Initial Certification

We offer many scheduling options to provide you with the most convenient and flexible choices. You may attend on a full time or part time basis. **Below is a popular scheduling option. Many variations are possible.**

Any prospective student can view class scheduling options online. From the Canisius Web site, click on "current students"; then click on "Online Registration/check your grades/view your 1098-T"; then click on "Class schedule" to view current, previous and some future semesters. **Note:** PEG courses are listed under the subject heading: Graduate Physical Education, EDU courses are listed under: Teacher Education, EDAD courses are listed under: Adolescence Education, and SPE courses are listed under: Special Education. Undergraduate Physical Education courses (PED) are listed under the subject heading: Physical Education.

Sample Schedules/Courses Offered for New Students – Summer 2009

Monday-Tuesday Program

During the summer, most campus based classes meet twice per week on Mon/Tue to complete a course in 5 weeks. During the fall and spring semesters, classes meet once per week.

Session 2 (June 29-July 31)***

PEG 503, section II, 9:30 am-1 pm

(Note: PEG 605 meets on Tue/Thur)

*PEG 511 A will normally be completed during Session 1. PEG 541 B will be completed during the fall semester. Each includes 50 hours of field experience.

**PEG 571 will normally be completed during the first semester.

***In order to be on track to student teach during the third semester, students should take two courses during Summer Session 2. You may take any 2 of the 3 courses listed or substitute an online course (PEG 530 or 560). Note that PEG 605 will meet once per week on Monday during the fall semester.

Web Option: Both US and Canadian students can limit their travel to campus by taking online courses to complete course requirements. No more than 50% of the program should be completed online to be in compliance with NY State and Ontario teaching certification requirements.

Certification coursework can be completed in 2 semesters, not considering prerequisite requirements. Student teaching placements may be completed during the third semester, in most cases. Student teaching is conducted Monday-Friday during the fall or spring semesters. Student teaching can not be completed during the summer. **See the Degree Requirement Summary (DRS) (yellow sheet) for additional program information.**
