

## **Scheduling Information for Physical Education (Spring 2010) Initial Certification**

We offer many scheduling options to provide you with the most convenient and flexible choices. You may attend on a full time or part time basis. Below is one of the most popular scheduling options.

Any prospective student can view class scheduling options online. From the Canisius Web site, click on "current students"; then click on "Online Registration/check your grades/view your 1098-T"; then click on "Class schedule" to view current, previous and some future semesters. **Note:** PEG courses are listed under the subject heading: Graduate Physical Education. Undergraduate Physical Education courses (PED) are listed under the subject heading: Physical Education.

### **Sample Schedules for New Students: Spring 2010 (January 19 – May 15)**

A typical student schedule for the spring semester is listed below. Many other variations are possible.

**PEG 503**, section A, **Monday-Tuesday**, 8:00-9:50 am **OR**

**PEG 504**, section A, **Monday-Tuesday**, 8:00-9:45 am

**\*PEG 511**, section A, **Monday**, 10:00 am-12:50 pm

**PEG 605**, section A, **Monday**, 4:30-7:00 pm

**\*\*PEG 571**, section A, **Tuesday**, 10:00 am-12:45 pm

\* PEG 511 will normally be completed during the first semester. PEG 541B will be completed during the second semester. Each includes 50 hours of field experience for US students. Canadian students complete 100 hours of field experience in PEG 572, normally taken during the second semester, instead of PEG 511 and PEG 541B.

\*\* PEG 571 will normally be completed during the first semester.

**If classes are closed while attempting to register**, contact the Graduate Education Office at 800-950-2505 or 888-2545. In most cases, we can add you to closed sections.

**Web courses** provide added flexibility toward completing program requirements. Two courses required for certification may be completed on-line: PEG 530 and PEG 560 (US students only). Web courses may be identified by the "WEB" section identifier on the registration screen. These courses are normally taken during the second semester via the Angel Learning System on the Canisius web site.

**During the summer**, (mid-May thru late July), Canisius offers two five-week sessions. Courses meet two times per week, including the Monday-Tuesday schedule.

Certification course work can be completed in 2 semesters. Student teaching placements may be completed during the third semester. Student teaching is conducted Monday-Friday during the fall or spring semesters. Student teaching can not be completed during the summer.
