BOSCH vs. FRISCH vs. DUGAN

Goal: To reduce the amount of energy used in on-campus residence halls.

Students from the Bosch, Frisch, and Dugan residence halls will compete to reduce the amount energy used in their building. Each week Facilities Management will run reports on energy usage in the three buildings. The competition will measure the amount of energy in kilowatt hours that is reduced compared to last years readings.

For example, if Bosch runs a report of 12438 kWH for the first week of January, 2009, compared to a reading of 13538 kWH from the same week in 2008, Bosch's reading for the week will be a reduction of 8.1%.

The contest will last 10 weeks long. Readings will be taken on:

- February 2
- February 9
- February 16
- February 23
- March 2
- March 9
- March 23
- March 30
- April 6
- April 20

The building with the largest total reduction of energy for the 10 week period will win an end of the year carnival for the entire building. The event will include free food, massages, prizes, live music, gaming and coffee and smoothies.
