Advanced Placement (AP) Credit Equivalencies

The following AP scores and course equivalencies apply to matriculating students. If a score report is not available at the time the initial schedule is made, students will be placed in entry- level courses. Student schedules will be changed once the college receives the score reports. No college credit is granted until official scores are received and evaluated by the Services Center. Canisius University may change AP score requirements or course equivalencies at any time. For more information about AP credit equivalencies, contact the Student Records & Financial Services Center. If you need to have an official score report sent, you must contact The College Board at 1-888-CALL-4-AP or www.collegeboard.org and reference the Canisius University Code: 2073. Students may apply up to 30 credits of college coursework completed while in high school towards their degrees.
