



# Finger Lakes Community College to Canisius College

## CORE CURRICULUM TRANSFER GUIDELINES

These general guidelines show how courses from Finger Lakes Community College (FLCC) serve to complete Canisius College's Core Curriculum requirements. Note that the FLCC course must be a regular course at the 100 level or above, count for a minimum of 3 credits, and meet the corresponding SUNY GEN ED requirements except where specific courses are indicated. Students must earn a course grade of C- or better for transfer credit to apply. Students can transfer a maximum of 60 credits to Canisius from FLCC or any other two-year college.
