CORE CURRICULUM TRANSFER GUIDELINES

These general guidelines show how courses from SUNY Erie serve to complete Canisius College's Core Curriculum requirements. Note that the SUNY Erie course must be a regular course at the 100 level or above, count for a minimum of 3 credits, and meet the corresponding SUNY GEN ED requirements except where specific courses are indicated. Students must earn a course grade of C- or better for transfer credit to apply. Students can transfer a maximum of 60 credits to Canisius from SUNY Erie or any other two-year college.
