

CHEMISTRY ANALYSES

NEW COMPOUNDS ARE PREPARED

Rev. T. Joseph Brown, S.J., head of the department of chemistry, announced the publication in the *Journal of the American Chemical Society* for September 1945, of new compounds, prepared in the Canisius College chemical laboratories by Mr. Gilbert Pitzel.

Mr. Pitzel received his Master of Science degree on June 10, 1945, after completing his laboratory work and submitting his thesis "The Preparation and Beckmann Rearrangement of 2-Propylcyclohexanone oxime."

The melting points and the analyses of the new compounds are given in the article and the results of the analyses correspond closely to the results calculated for the identification of the compounds.

Mr. Pitzel received his B.S. degree from Syracuse University and is employed as a research chemist by the DuPont de Nemours Co., Inc. He was assisted in the preparation and identification of the new compounds by Dr. A. D. McLarnen who is also in the DuPont Research Laboratories.
