Jesuit members of the Science staffs of the college attended the 24th annual meeting of the American Association of Jesuit Scientists which was conducted on Aug. 30, 31, and Sept. 1 at Fordham University, New York. Canisius was represented on the program of speakers.

Biology Dept. Chairman Father John A. Frisch, S.J., before relinquishing his office as president of

the Association's Eastern States Division, delivered the Presidential Address entitled: "Biological Evolution Is a Fact," and subsequently delivered an address dealing with "The 'Killer Factor' in *Paramecium Aurelia*."

Father James J. Pallace, S.J., of the Canisius Chemical Dept., whose services as a consultant were recently requested by the Director of Research of the Monsanto Chemical Co., also delivered a paper before the Association. His topic was: "Some New Experiments in Physical Chemistry."
